- Kids Healthline calls up 23%
- Beyond Blue calls up 20%

- 1 in 10 women exp violence during pandemic
  - 33% first time
  - 53% physical or sexual violence

- # people gambling more than 4x a week is up 23-32%

This report only considers 50% of int'l arrivals, what do closed borders mean going forward?

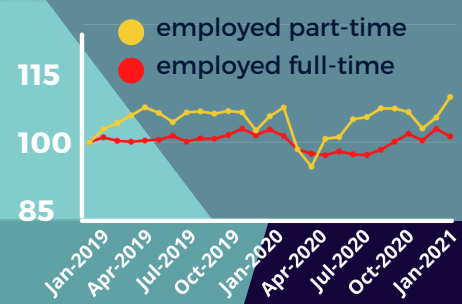
- Accommodation: ↑ Domestic travel costs

- Hospitality, Retail, Tourism: ↓ Revenue & ↑ costs
